Enhancing Communication and Learning Through Sign Language

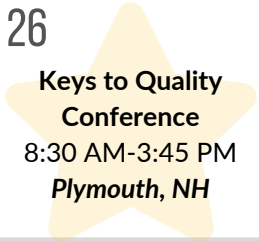
**4th Thursday of the month
