Become a license-exempt provider!

In the state of New Hampshire, an individual can provide care in their home for up to four children in addition to their own and be a license-exempt provider.

- While not licensed, if a license-exempt provider cares for a child receiving a child care state scholarship, the provider must meet certain health and safety requirements.
